Haruhiko mikimoto, the original character designer for the first TV series in 1982 and Macross 7, has provided a newly drawn key visual featuring Mylene Flare Jenius and Basara Nekki from Macross 7 for the shop, it is expected to have various .Macross merchandise including apparels and accessories, with a gallery space .

Mikimoto's real name is Haruhiko Satō is a comic book artist, illustrator, anime character designer. Mostly active during the 1980s, during that time he rose to fame and is considered one of the top character designers of his time. He was born on August 28, 1959 in Tokyo, Japan. He graduated from Keio University. He became animator of Artland while attending school, and took charge of the Model sheet of The Super Dimension Fortress Macross.

.Mel Kishida is a Illustrator/character designer. Debuted with illustrations for "Paracelsus no Musume" by Yu Godai . Making illustrations for light novels under numerous labels, regardless of the targeted gender group. This artist became widely known after being selected for character design for Gust's famous game series, . Now, he is one of the most targeted illustrators. His colorful illustrations have a sense of transparency, and they radiate a unique charm even with the many character illustrations.

Tetsuya Nomura is video game designer artist who is know for his art in the game final fantasy Compared to other character designers, Tetsuya Nomura's Final Fantasy games tend to be

more modern and sci-fi than the first installments in the Final Fantasy games set in a medieval worlds. Nomura's games in particular also tend to have storylines that are darker in tone. In addition, his character names tend to draw inspiration from physical science and weather, in particular, the sky, land, and sea; the central character almost always has the sky-based name. He was thinking of dropping that tradition for Lightning from Final Fantasy XIII, but the other creative figures behind the character chose a sky-based name. Nomura also creates character names inspired by their personalities.

Yoshitaka Amano is an illustrator and animator best known for his work on comic books and video games. Born in Shizuoka, Japan, he developed an interest in art at an early age. After taking a job at Tatsunoko Productions in 1967, he discovered the world of anime. He worked on a number of different anime shows and movies for the company. Amano often drew inspiration from Western art, including the Art Nouveau and Pop Art movements. In the 1980s, he began working on comic books and graphic novels, starting with Demon City Shinjuku and Vampire Hunter D. After taking a job with Square, he began to work on video games.

By the 2000s, Amano discovered the world of freelance work, which gave him the chance to work with top artists such as Neil Gaiman. The two worked together on Sandman: The Dream Hunters, which received a Hugo Award nomination. He also worked with Greg Rucka on Elektra and Wolverine: The Redeemer. When not working on graphic novels and comic books, Amano collaborated with the band Galneryus; the artist created several album covers for the group. In 2010, he opened his own production company, which works on movies and other projects.

Amano currently lives and works in Paris, France, Tokyo, Japan, and New York, NY.
